

KATHERINE MULHERIN AND CLINT GRIFFIN

Two local heroes team up to launch a new art adventure. Katherine Mulherin — founder and curator of BUSgallery, 1080BUS and schoolBUS — opens her new gallery on Friday (Oct. 10). Appropriately enough, this one — her “space to call home” — is called the Katherine Mulherin Gallery. To launch this new space is *as tourist jacket*, a new exhibition by Clint Griffin. Griffin, a mixed media artist who “pulls the notion of delicate interconnectedness together through the use of fine lines, text, photographs and expressionist painting,” was also responsible for the inaugural show at BUS two years ago. His new work is described as “through disguise-like devices, seeing home as a tourist would.” It’s bound to be a fine beginning
